This is a Service Rifle and 4X Optics Match, competitors in different classes will be given different color score cards. The Match rules will follow the MCL service rifle match rules fired at 100yds on a NRA SR-1 10X target. The optics match will run under the same rules, except weapon type is any Service Rifle with a 4X power scope or lower, this year you will be able to shoot both classes as long as you pay the extra \$15 fee. All competitors must be 18 years old on the date of the event, sign a release and hold harmless agreement and supply their own ammo. The cost for each shooter is \$30, if you wish to shoot the optics class, in addition to the service match the cost will be an extra \$15. Registration must be done by Sept. 21 2019 and the match will be limited to 200 score cards. The forms and hold harmless agreements are available at <http://www.mclcb.org/Department/Rifle.html> and information on submitting the forms will be there as well. Scores from the service match will be eligible for the MCL National Postal Rifle Match as long as the shooter is a member in good standing in the Marine Corps League, shoots 10 shots offhand, 10 rounds kneeling, 10 rounds sitting, 10 shots prone, and pays the National Postal Match \$15 fee, more details will be available at the event. There is no Optics Class in the National Postal Match. We can do this because this year we are shooting on a 10X target. The "GROVE" next to the range is available for campers and camping for no charge; the Range just asks that we don't over use the well located in the grove. Anyone wishing to camp should let us know in advance.

There will be food for sale at the range house we ask that you please get your food from the range as we will be organizing the food according to the number of applications any special food needs please contact Joe Kier.
